Armenian Genocide

The Armenian Genocide was the treacherous massacre of what was potentially millions during World War I. These killings would soon lead up to the deportation of Armenians to the deserts, where surviving took pure luck, as many died from harsh conditions or from being killed by others passing by.

The definition of a genocide is the “deliberate killing of a large number of people from a particular nation or ethnic group with the aim of destroying that nation or group”.

The Armenian Genocide is something never to be forgotten nor repeated in history, as the horrible conditions many faced before death was absolutely tragic. Still, today, many Armenians continue to go on marches on April 24th to commemorate those who died, and to remind us never to forget what happened.
