CLASSROOM USE:

(Due to storage space, students with last names A-L will bring in the classroom items listed below at Supply Drop Off in August 2023; students with last names M-Z will bring in on January 2024. Place the listed items below in a brown paper bag with the child's full name.)

- 3 boxes of Kleenex
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 3-pack Lysol or Clorox disinfecting wipes
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer
- 1 pack of Expo Marker (regular sized-assorted colors)
- 1 ream of computer/printer paper (white)

PERSONAL: (All the items below should be labelled with the student's name)

- One backpack - **NO WHEELS (This is for safety reasons)**
- One lunchbox
- Re-usable water bottle (labeled with student name)

 - Large glue stick

 - Four highlighters (assorted colors)
 - Two packs of post-it notes (sticky tops)
 - Pencil pouch
 - Pocket folder (5) for each subject
 - 6 College Ruled composition notebooks (other subjects)
 - Spiral-bound college-ruled notebook for Math
 - One packet of quad-rule graph paper (8th grade only)
 - Plastic storage Art box (six-quart clear - students may use box from previous year)
