A few drop off and pick up reminders:

- Do not drive through the drop off lanes.
- Do not drive west from Ranchito heading towards Hazeltine.
- Do not make U-turns on Community Street.
- No right turn from Hazeltine to head east onto Community Street.
- Please no dropping of or picking up in the middle of the road. (Mostly when late or in a rush)
- Please stop arriving 30 minutes before the designated pick-up time. This adds to the frustration of yourself, other parents, and our neighbors.
- If you arrive early, park on Roscoe and wait for your child to text you (if they have a phone)
- Please do not block driveways and be respectful to our neighbors.

Just a quick reminder, these pick-up rules are still in place during NIGHT SCHOOLS. Please pick your HS student up in the SAME location as during a regular school day. MS has the special location of Hazeltine on night school days.

A few reminders about coming on campus:

- Email or call ahead if you are going to pick up your child early for an appointment. It is a process that sometimes may take time, we understand you are in a hurry but give extra time if you do not call or email ahead.
- Parents please do not come to campus expecting to see administration or a teacher without an appointment.
- Please reach out to them via email and establish communication with them. We will verify with them there is an appointment scheduled before signing you in.
- No appointment no entrance.

While these things may feel like small inconveniences, they add up to a big safety difference for our most precious possession during school hours – your children! Thank you for your continued support and patience. Have a blessed weekend.
