
## **Homecoming Change War-Support SG!**

## St. Genevieve Girl's Academy-South Sudan:

Did you know that St. Genevieve built and sustains a school for girls in South Sudan? Yes, it's true! Our sister school, St. Genevieve Girl's Academy, is on the continent of African in the country of South Sudan. Over the past eleven years, St. Geneive has raised over \$78,000 to build a school and pay for its operations. Today the school educates over 50 girls. Bishop Eduardo Kussala, the bishop in charge of the school, has visited our school twice, most recently in August 2023.





## 2. Elementary School and High School Endowment:

Both our schools have an endowment fund. An endowment fund is a savings/investment fund in which we never use the principal (money deposited in the account) but instead use the interest earned on the fund to support school operations. We continue to add money to the account every year and that increases the interest we earn. All students benefit from the endowment fund.
