November 3 (Friday)

Conferences are required for all students/parents with the exception of those finishing the trimester with a 3.6 GPA and above. The teacher will notify you on or before November 8 if you are exempt from a conference. Students should plan on attending the conference with their parent.

High School

High School families I want to thank you for waiting for the text from your child or children that they are ready and at the pickup spot. Thank you for your continued patience and understanding.

Yesterday we did have a few sophomores and freshmen parents arrive early. Wait for the text, sometimes our students don't rush out and may cause you to go back around you the parent gets frustrated and lets it out on my team members.

Everyone deserves to be treated respectfully on this campus - it is not acceptable to be rude or disrespectful to any person on this campus. Let us all try and model Christ - even when it's late and we're all tired! Thank you.

Please wait for the text that says "I am ready" or prepare to circle back around. Thank you

Middle School

7th & 8th Grade families thank you for not arriving early and cooperating with us I genuinely appreciate you and the communication you have with your families who pick up your child or children. Night school we are getting better at not parking across the street in redzones and picking up in the middle of the road.

Sports pick up has a designated pick-up spot the 7th and 8th grade lanes.

K-6: We need your help.

Please stop arriving early.

When you arrive early - it causes unnecessary backups on Hazeltine Street and Murrieta Street.

Although, I have asked many of you repeatedly to not block driveways or move trashcans - many of you still do and tell the neighbors "I'll just be five minutes." *What if that were your house? What if you needed to leave and someone told you they would move from blocking your driveway in 5 minutes?*

It goes without saying - that's not cool at all.

Not only is it not respectful to our neighbors, but it doesn't allow for emergency vehicles to (Ambulance or Firetruck) to respond as needed.

Yesterday because we were all lined up at 2:10pm on Murrieta an accident occurred when our neighbor tried to pull out in-between all of our cars. Neighbors will call parking enforcement and they have informed us they will issue tickets.

I promise you - I have spoken to Ms. Allen - you have a full 15 minute window to pick up your student. The teacher will not leave them - so consider arriving 5 minutes after pick up time to give yourself some peace of mind and to minimize the traffic.
