All students are required to bring all the supplies on this list prior to the start of the academic year. Drop off supplies and meet the teacher on **Friday, August 9 between 9am-1pm.**

FOR THE CLASSROOM

(Due to storage space, students with last names A-L will bring in the classroom items listed below at Supply Drop Off in August 2023; Students with last names M-Z will bring on January 2024. Place the listed items below in a brown paper bag with the child's full name.)

- 3 boxes of Kleenex / facial tissue
- 1 jumbo container Lysol or Clorox Disinfecting wipes
- 1 bottle of Purell hand sanitizer
- 1 pack of post-it notes (sticky tops)
- 1 pack 3x5 (100 count) index cards
- 1 pack of Expo Markers (regular sized, assorted colors)
- Large packet of white index cards (5x8)

PERSONAL: (PLEASE LABEL WITH STUDENT NAME)

- One backpack **NO WHEELS (This is for safety reasons)** *Minimal items are sent home nightly.*
- One lunchbox (labeled with the child's name)
- Reusable water bottle (labeled with the child's name)

- Packet of at least 10 mechanical pencils with extra lead (0.7mm or 0.9mm)
 - Clear Ruler (not bendable)
 - Packet of blue or black pens and 2 red pens (medium/fine point)
 - 2- 3 Highlighters (assorted colors)
 - A pencil pouch / container
 - 2 plastic folders
 - 4 college-ruled composition notebooks (cardboard covers)
 - Graphing composition book for Math
 - 2 Reams of College Ruled paper (100 sheets each)
 - Clipboard (any color)

ART SUPPLIES: separate labeled bag from classroom supplies. ALL STUDENTS A-Z should have this in Aug.

- 1-Sterilite Plastic Storage Box (**11 ½ L x 7 5/8 W x 2 7/8 H**) *Ok to re-use box from previous grade.*
 - Small watercolor set
 - Oil pastels
 - Box of assorted colored markers and colored pencils
 - 4 glue sticks (no jumbo sizes)
 - 1 pack of baby wipes
 - 1 paper towel roll
 - Medium size scissors

BAND SUPPLIES:

- ASSIGNED INSTRUMENT (refer to ES Band Director)
- Cleaning kit for *assigned instrument (refer to ES Band Director)

ADDITIONAL NOTE:

- All textbooks must be covered at home during the first week of school.
- No fabric/stretchy covers.
- Use thick brown paper bags/material.
- Label the book cover with book title and student name.
- No tape used on the book itself please!
